

"It will not scratch surfaces, as long as you apply it with a non-scratch sponge or microfiber cloth," she says. A fairy dusting of this powdered multi-purpose cleaner goes a long way. "It can be used successfully to remove scuffs, rust, and food stains, whether dried on or burned on. It can also bring a scum-covered shower door to a shine.
